Energy efficiency: **Lisini Pub Group**

- Ran a behaviour change campaign which reduced their electricity bills by 20%.

Code Hostels

Installed an energy management system in 2020. Over the 3 years, it's saved them over £15,000 by highlighting energy inefficiencies such as heating being left on overnight
